D. How Long Will We Retain Your Data?

The data will be processed for the period during which liabilities may arise between the parties, with a minimum retention period of five (5) years.

E. Legal Basis for Processing

The legal basis for processing reservation data is the performance of a contract between the parties.

F. Obligation to Provide Data and Consequences of Failure to Provide It

The requested data is mandatory; otherwise, the reservation process cannot be completed.

G. Source of the Data

The data subject.

II. Recipients of the Data

- a) No personal data will be disclosed to third parties.
- b) No international transfers of personal data will be carried out.

III. Exercise of Rights

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not we are processing personal data concerning you.

As a data subject, you have the right to access your personal data, request the rectification of inaccurate data and, where appropriate, request the erasure of your data when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

Under certain circumstances, you may request the restriction of processing of your personal data, in which case we will only retain the data for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Under certain circumstances and on grounds relating to your particular situation, you may object to the processing of your personal data. In such cases, we will cease processing your data unless there are compelling legitimate grounds for continuing the processing or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Where the processing of your personal data is based on your consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time.

Where legally applicable, you have the right to data portability. This means that you have the right to receive the personal data concerning you that we process in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to store it on your own device. You may also request that we transmit such data to another data controller.

Furthermore, if you believe that there is a problem or incident relating to the processing of your personal data, you may contact the company using the contact details provided in this document. In any event, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority for data protection matters. In Spain, this authority is the Spanish Data Protection Agency (Agencia Española de Protección de Datos – AEPD).
